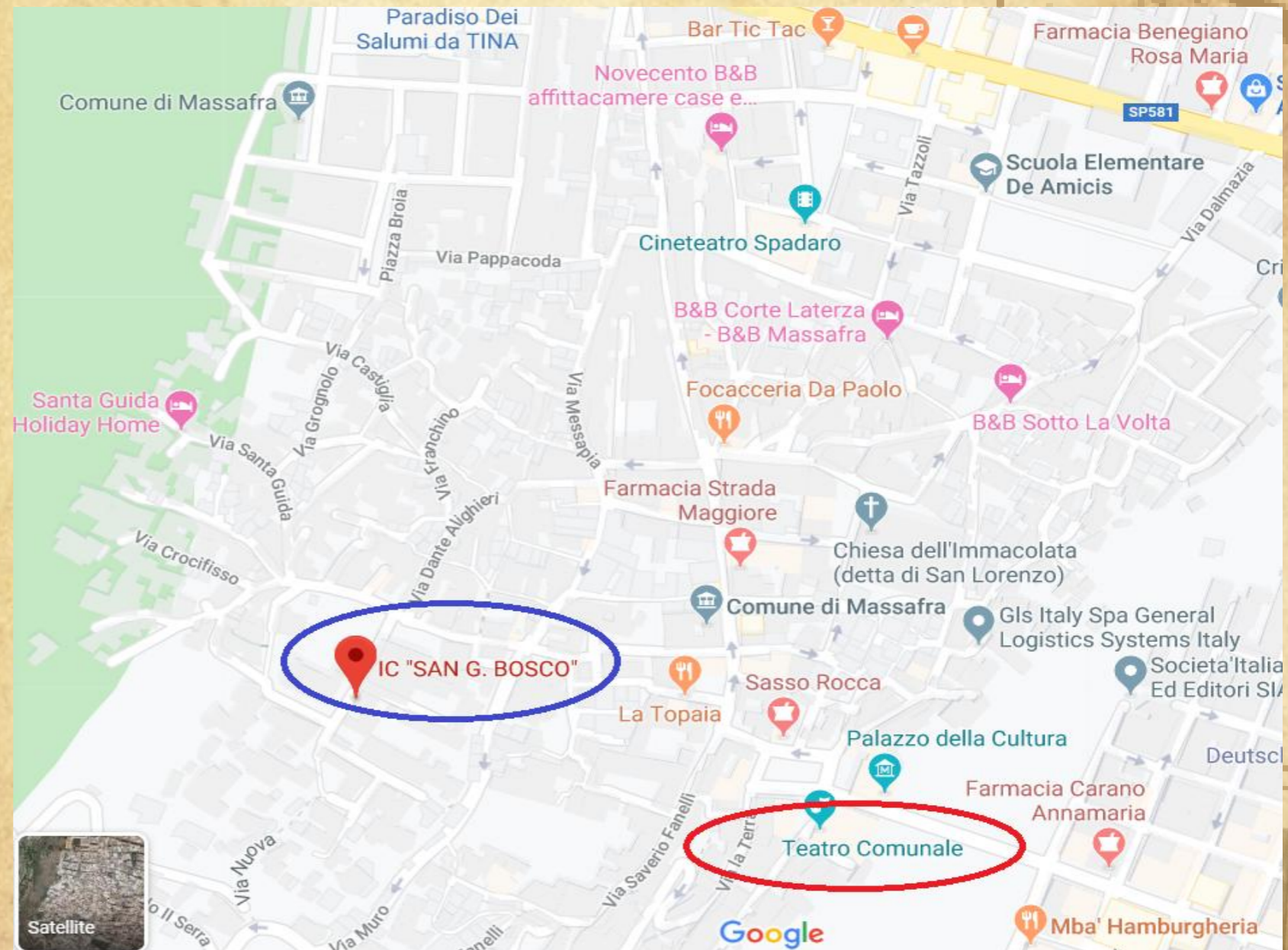

About Massafra

Finds of the Neolithic period date back the origins of Massafra to primitive human settlements. It seems that in 754 BC a fortified village already existed on the hill, whose people then moved to the Gravina of Madonna della Scala below. From the 6th-7th century onwards, with the Greek-Byzantine immigration, it was the period of Rock Civilization of which direct remains have been found throughout the territory. The first historical mention of the town dates however to the 10th century, when it was a Lombard Gastaldato.

After the Norman conquest, it was part of the Principality of Taranto, to which, as a free town, it belonged until 1463. In 1484 Massafra was occupied by the Aragonese army. In 1497 it was sacked by the troops of Charles VIII of France. When French were defeated by the Spanish in 1504, Massafra was a province of the Kingdom of Naples and Sicily until 1861 with a break between 1799 and 1815 during the French occupation with Napoleon. In 1861 Massafra, like the entire South, became part of the Kingdom of Italy. After the II World War Italy became a Republic.

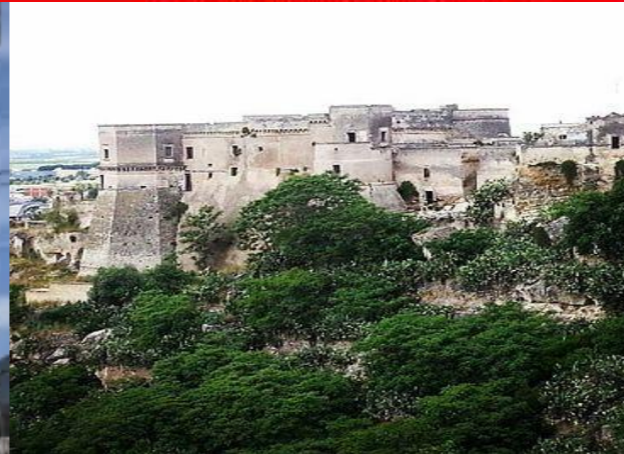

About Massafra



Suspended between faith and legends, ravines and deep blades, Massafra preserves its treasures in the rock. In “Gravina of San Marco” ancient rock churches are set. In “Gravina of Madonna della Scala” hypogaeum it’s possible to visit the homonymous sanctuary, ancient rock churches with bizantyne frescos and several housing units (caves), the impressive “Magician Greguro pharmacy”. The old town also boasts valuable architecture such as the ancient Mother Church, built in the 16th century on the oldest structure of a crypt, the Baroque Church of Sant'Agostino and the seventeenth-century Baroque Convent of San Benedetto.
